

RESOLUTION NO. 2001-05

A RESOLUTION FOR THE CHEROKEE VILLAGE COUNCIL, SHARP AND FULTON COUNTIES, ARKANSAS, IN THE MATTER OF DISPOSAL OF HYPODERMIC NEEDLES USED FOR MEDICAL PURPOSES

WHEREAS, our Municipal Health Officer, Dr. William V. Relyea, has requested for the safety and well being of Cherokee Village residents, and;

WHEREAS, hypodermic needles may be placed in a red biohazard disposable container, which may be purchased from a pharmacy, and placed next to the waste disposal container at the time of regularly scheduled trash pick-up; or,

WHEREAS, one's personal physician may be able to assist with the disposal of used hypodermic needles; or,

WHEREAS, hypodermic needles may be placed in a bleach bottle with a lid or any heavy plastic bottle with a lid and marked either "biohazard" or "medical waste," with a magic marker, and placed next to the waste disposal container at the time of the regularly scheduled trash pick-up;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it RESOLVED by the City Council, with concurrence of the Mayor:

1. To dispose of the said medical waste in stated procedure.
