A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING THE WILLINGNESS OF

Signalization of Highway 62/412 and Highway 175S

WHEREAS, The City of Cherokee Village understands Federal-Aid Surface Transportation Funds are available for certain City projects at the following Federal participating ratios:
